HOW BELIEVERS SHOULD ACT

Titus 3:1 - 2

Remind them to be For we too were once...

Titus 3:1-2

- Submissive to authorities
- Obedient
- Ready for every good work
- Slander no one
- Avoid fighting
- Be kind
- Showing gentleness

Titus 3:3

- Foolish
- Disobedient
- Deceived
- Enslaved by passion/pleasure
- Living in malice and envy
- Hateful
- Detesting one another



Titus 3:4-5

But, when the **kindness** of God our Savior **and His love** for mankind appeared, **HE SAVED US** - not by **works of righteousness** that we had done, but according to His mercy - through the **washing of regeneration** and **renewal** by the Holy Spirit.

Washing of regeneration and renewal?

- Isaiah 36:26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will remove your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.
- Romans 12:2 Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God.

- Be open to the instruction of seasoned believers
