


- They oppose God (1 Thess. 2:17-18).

- Satan uses various "devices" to gain a foothold or advantage over the believer (1 Cor. 7:3-5).

- Satan demands permission to "sift" or test believers (Luke 22:31-34).
- Evil angels set traps for church leaders to discredit or destroy the effectiveness of their ministries (2 Tim. 2:24-26).



- Satan exercises dominion over the world system (1 John 5:19).
- Satan functions as the spiritual father of the unsaved (John 8:44).
- Satan tries to prevent the unsaved from becoming saved (Luke 8:12, 2 Cor. 4:4).



- Every false religion (1 Cor. 10:19-20)
- As counterfeit believers and false teachers to infiltrate local churches and other ministries (2 Peter 2:1-3)
